CORE PROGRAM

The Core Program provides established leaders from all parts of New Mexico an in-depth, nonpartisan, educational experience not available anywhere else. Each session features presentations by recognized experts on topics of concern for New Mexico, including health and human services, economic development, education, environment and natural resources, government, and crime and justice. Sessions introduce participants to communities and local leaders across the state that many would not otherwise encounter. The program has an informative leadership skill enhancement component. Participants graduate with new knowledge, insights, and a statewide network to improve New Mexico and its diverse communities and regions.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

The Local Government Leadership Program is an educational partnership between the New Mexico Municipal League, the New Mexico Association of Counties, the New Mexico School Board Association, and Leadership New Mexico. The organizations have joined together to provide a unique experience for municipal and county officials, New Mexico school board members, members of the New Mexico National Guard, and regional councils of governments. The curriculum provides local leaders information to explore issues facing New Mexico, offers skill-building workshops, and encourages leaders to turn knowledge into action. The Local Government Leadership Program prepares local officials to undertake their civic responsibility and instill in them a passion for effective and ethical public service.

CONNECT NEW MEXICO PROGRAM

Connect New Mexico “The Next Generation of Leadership” is an educational program for 25 to 40-year-old professionals from around the state. Connect New Mexico allows participants to develop leadership skills, learn how New Mexico’s systems and structures work, and explore the issues facing the state. The program provides participants with knowledge and skills they can use to be effective leaders in their communities and the state. The program creates a bond between young professionals, the communities they live in, and the State of New Mexico to promote well informed positive change.





AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

2017 DISTINGUISHED ALUMNUS AWARD

The Leadership New Mexico Distinguished Alumnus Award was established in 2003 to recognize a Leadership New Mexico graduate whose leadership activities exemplify the highest standards, achieved statewide significance, and used his or her leadership skills, knowledge and resources to benefit New Mexico.



John Hummer | Core Class of 2004

Hummer is Co-Founder and President of Burrell College of Osteopathic Medicine at New Mexico State University in Las Cruces. Previously, he was the developer and founding Chief Executive Officer of Mountain View Regional Medical Center in Las Cruces. Hummer has 28 years of experience in the healthcare industry in locations throughout the United States. Hummer and his wife also own the largest full service real estate company in Las Cruces and Southern New Mexico, Steinborn Inc. Real Estate. He is a Board Director for First American Bank headquartered in Artesia, the Southwest Osteopathic Foundation for Education and Research, and the Borderplex Alliance. He has served in the past as Chairman of the Mesilla Valley Economic Development Alliance, President of the Rio Grande Rotary Club, and President of the Downtown Las Cruces Partnership. He served as Chairman of the Greater Las Cruces Chamber of

Commerce and is a two-time recipient of their Citizen of the Year award. Hummer served six years as a Commissioner for the New Mexico Department of Transportation. He was Co-Chairman of People for Aerospace, which led the successful campaign for Spaceport America.

2017 DISTINGUISHED LEADERSHIP AWARD

The Distinguished Leadership Award recognizes individuals who use their leadership skills to improve the quality of life for the citizens of New Mexico.



Dale R. Dekker

Dekker is a founder of Dekker/Perich/Sabatini (D/P/S), an architecture, engineering, and planning firm that employs more than 170 people across three states. D/P/S is the 36th largest private sector business in Albuquerque and is ranked 130th in Architectural Record's top national architectural firms. Dekker has extensive experience in socially, economically, and environmentally sustainable architecture and planning projects. He contributed to high-tech research facilities for Sandia National Laboratories, award-winning school designs across the Southwest, and large-scale master plans such as the UNM Master Plan Update. Dekker served on the Customer Advisory Committee of the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority, and helped develop a comprehensive plan for Wildfire and Water Source Protection for the Rio Grande Water Fund. He also served as an Executive

Committee member for both Albuquerque Economic Development and the Greater Albuquerque Chamber of Commerce, a National Board Member of NAIOP, and the Past-District Council Chair of the Urban Land Institute.
