A graduate of Boston College, and Columbia University, Peter Trevisani is the first Club President, CEO, and majority owner of New Mexico United. He is motivated by a commitment to community, a love of competition, and a concrete belief that soccer can pave the path to

meaningful growth in the state of New Mexico.

Born just outside of Boston, MA, sometime between the Boston Tea Party and Tom Brady being drafted, Peter attended Boston College where he played the other kind of football: American Football. After graduating, and attempting to go pro in Italy, he spent three years building personal computers for small businesses in Boston before trading his floppy drive in for a calculator and embarking on the path of finance. It started with an MBA from Columbia University and finished 16 years later in Santa Fe, NM, where he was a Partner at Thornburg Investment Management.

After leaving Thornburg in 2015, Peter wrote down 5 things that he loved, besides his family. One was immersive theater. His passion for immersive theater led to an early investment and advisory work with the Santa Fe art collective, Meow Wolf. Another was health and fitness. This inspired "Project 47" a self-induced fitness challenge where Peter worked out for 47 days in a row, but each workout involved a different fitness discipline. This challenge led Peter to some familiar workouts such as CrossFit and mountain biking, but it also found him in some less comfortable environments, such as a water aerobics class and playing dodgeball with the 6th grade class at his son's school.

Peter also listed the word "Community." It was this single word that inspired him to lead a group of like-minded individuals who shared his vision to inspire and elevate fellow New Mexicans. The medium for this change and inspiration...soccer. Peter sees this team as a vehicle for community engagement and the catalyst for systemic change. The club will compete at an elite level, with the foundational goals of winning the USL and Open Cup, but beyond that, it will overtly, and positively improve the self-worth of this beautiful state.

management career as an intern with the city manager's office in Greenville, Texas, followed by another internship with the county manager's office in Johnson County (Olathe), Kansas, and as a management analyst with the City of Houston, Texas. He holds a bachelor's degree in Spanish Translation and a master's degree in public administration from Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah. He has been a Credentialed Manager (ICMA-CM) with the International City/County Management Association (ICMA) since April 2016, of which he has been a member since 2000. He has been a member of the New Mexico City Management Association (NMCMA), a subsection of the New Mexico Municipal League (NMML), since 2012, serving as its president from 2021-2022. Gregory is a 2015 graduate of Leadership New Mexico's Local Government Leadership Program and a 2023 graduate of Leadership New Mexico's Core Program.

About Our Leadership Programs

Core Program

The Core Program provides established leaders from all parts of New Mexico an indepth, nonpartisan educational experience not available anywhere else in the state. Each session features presentations by recognized experts on topics of concern for New Mexico, including health and human services, economic development, education, environment and natural resources, government, crime, and justice. Sessions introduce participants to communities and local leaders across the state that many wallnot otherwise encounter. Participants graduate with new knowledge, insights, and a statewide network to improve New Mexico and its diverse communities and regions.

Connect New Mexico The Next Generation of Leadership

Connect New Mexico is an educational program for 25 to 40-year-old professionals from around the state. Connect New Mexico allows participants to develop leadership skills, learn how New Mexico's systems and structures work, and explore issues facing the state. The program provides participants with knowledge and skills to become effective leaders in their communities and the state. The program creates a bond between young professionals, the communities they live in, and the state of New Mexico to promote well-informed, positive change.

Local Government Leadership Program

The Local Government Leadership Program prepares local officials to undertake their civic responsibility with a passion for effective and ethical public service. The program is an educational partnership between the New Mexico Municipal League, New Mexico Counties, New Mexico School Board Association, and Leadership New Mexico. The organizations have joined together to provide a unique experience for municipal and county officials, New Mexico school board members, members of the New Mexico National Guard, and regional councils of governments. The curriculum provides local leaders with an opportunity to explore issues facing New Mexico, attend skill-building workshops, and encourage leaders to turn their knowledge into action.

Alumni Program

The Alumni Program continues the Leadership New Mexico experience long after the initial program has ended. Through engaging tours and unique, members-only events, graduates from all three programs continue to be exposed to a diversity of experiences and regional perspectives that foster professional and personal relationships, promote community and business development, and advance statewide progress.
